Dear Families,

The conflict in Ukraine is tragic and many people in our St. Nicholas community have been affected by this unprovoked war. On Tuesday, March 1st, all EICS schools will be standing in solidarity with the people of Ukraine by wearing the national colours of blue and yellow. At 11:00 a.m., we will have a moment of silence across the division to pray for peace in the Eastern Europe. We offer a prayer for peace as we support the people in Ukraine:



God of infinite mercy and goodness, with grateful hearts we pray to you today for Peace. You offer us your peace continually and constantly remind us that peacemakers are blessed. We pray to you for the people of Ukraine who are experiencing conflict and death. Bless the leaders with wisdom, vision and perseverance needed to build together a world of justice and solidarity, and to break down walls of hostility and division. To you we pray that the people of Ukraine may never yield to discouragement and despair, but become heralds of new hope to one another in this challenging time. Lord, grant peace to Ukraine. We pray through Christ our Lord, Amen.

As we approach the season of Lent we are reminded that this season provides us a time to prepare for the essence of our faith - the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday (March 2) and lasts 40 days. We participate in Lent through Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. Students and staff will participate in a virtual Ash Wednesday mass at 12:15pm. Classroom teachers will be distributing ashes to students (following Covid protocols set forth by the parish). Shrove Tuesday falls on the Tuesday before Lent (March 1). On this day, we traditionally eat pancakes, syrup, and sausages. In the past, the reason for this delicious meal was to use up foods such as butter, eggs, and milk before Lent. On Tuesday, students will receive individually wrapped pancakes and sausages from Headquarters restaurant paid for by our School Council. We are asking students to bring in a toonie that day to assist School Council to offset some of the costs.
